


HOOK COMMUNITY COUNCIL

Do you qualify?

- Are you a qualifying British Subject, Commonwealth or EU Citizen aged 18 years and over, and Have you lived in, or within three miles of Hook for the last three months?
 - Are you a registered elector in the area: or
 - Have you occupied as owner or tenant, any land or premises in the area for the preceding twelve months: or
 - Is your principal or only work in the area of Hook for the preceding twelve months
- You must not be disqualified from holding office as a Councillor.
